The Excitement is Building at Friede & Associates in Wisconsin

Spend just a little time at the Friede & Associates headquarters in the southcentral community of Reedsburg, Wisconsin, and you quickly realize this is not just another general contractor waiting for their next project to bid. Instead of hearing staff members complaining about non-performing subcontractors and material price increases, the conversations around this office center on getting initial concept drawings developed and approved by owners, the need to find public funding and municipal approval for planned projects, and cash flow analysis of potential future projects with various developers looking for new development opportunities.

This is not your father's general contracting firm-and yet in many ways it is. President Roger Friede runs this fourth-generation family business that was started by his great grandfather in the early 1900's and passed on through the years to his father in the 1950's and that he took over in the 1990's. Friede is a company that prides itself on its family values and providing a place where employees can start and finish their construction careers decades later. Friede θ Associates is also a company



that looks to develop long term relationships with its customers and its trade partners. A firm that has delivered nearly 90% of its projects on a preselected and open book method of project delivery over the last five years. Which brings us back to all the discussions about how to help their clients' projects move forward. It is this focus on "pre-construction" services and customer satisfaction that truly separates the Friede team from other contractors in their marketplace and has earned them our Corporate America Today Contractor of the Year for Wisconsin award for 2021.

With most corporations, let alone contractors, pulling back in the face of the global pandemic of 2020, Friede once again went against the grain and chose to instead add new resources for its clients in the form of preliminary architectural design assistance, and added Carole Shaffer, a new Vice President of Business Development who had led a trade association of developers

in the Madison, WI marketplace for nearly a dozen years before moving into the construction field. When teamed up with company co-owner Scott Truehl, who had spent nearly 20 years working in economic development and elected governmental positions prior to joining the firm in 1998, and Matt Krogman, a former employment recruiter and commercial banker who joined the firm in 2017, the Friede "preconstruction team" can absolutely take projects from concept to completion.

"Roger and I decided years ago that we wanted our firm to be different. One that both clients and our team members enjoyed being a part of," Truehl noted. "We realized early on that most of our clients really were not excited about building and expanding their physical structures, and very few of them had ever gone through the process. So, we decided to assemble a team that can help them with finding the proper site; developing preliminary plans and budgets; obtain municipal approvals and



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identify and negotiate public incentives if appropriate; and to assist our clients in obtaining conventional financing. And to do it all for them at little or no cost, just so we could build them their new facility."

Recent Friede projects include a major expansion of a successful veterinary service, a new brewery/restaurant/ meeting facility and a volleyball facility all that were aided by Friede negotiating significant six figure public incentives on the behalf of their clients. Dozens of current projects are also benefiting from our profound architectural services on offer, including virtual 3-D renderings of what the building or renovation can look like, helping Friede clients visualize what their project will look like when completed.

The Friede estimating department works throughout the process to provide real time cost estimates to establish and maintain project budgets, rather than having a prospect pay for complete architectural drawings and then hope the end product matches their budget. Friede & Associates recently followed this exact process on their largest project ever, when they team up with Kalahari Resorts & Waterpark in the development of their \$30 million, 125,000-square-foot convention center addition in the Wisconsin Dells. The Friede team worked closely with Architectural Design Consultants, Inc. (ADCI), the project architect, for nearly nine months of project design to price virtually every element of the project prior to the 18-month project beginning in the fall of 2017. By working together, the project team (Kalahari, ADCI & Friede) was able to deliver the project under budget and open fully a month ahead of schedule.

The growth of the firm over the last few years has also allowed them to attain a healthy balance of experienced and younger employees. The future also looks bright as they not only have been able to add staff to help with their preconstruction services over the last year, but also open a new office in Madison to better serve their current and future customers across southern Wisconsin.
